



Long Term Care Hospitals

Most people who need inpatient hospital services are admitted to an “acute care” hospital, such as DRH Health, for a relatively short stay. But some people may require a more extended hospital stay. Long term care hospitals (LTCHs) are certified as acute care hospitals, but LTCHs focus on patients who stay for more than 25 days. LTCHs specialize in treating patients who may more than one serious condition, but who may improve with time and care, and return home. (CMS Product No. I1347)
